Eighteen weeks of "Day Drinking" has brought the beloved Capitol Nashville quartet to the top of the MusicRow Chart this week.



It is the first single from *Pain Killer*, an album set for release October 21. Writing credits for

the single come from **Troy Verges**, **Barry Dean** and the group's **Karen Fairchild**, **Jimi Westbrook** and **Phillip Sweet**.

Jay Joyce's wistful production is mesmerizing, almost anthemic for a Sunday fun day, or a weekend feeling the breeze of the water. *MusicRow's* Robert K. Oermann noted of the single on June 25, "Audio addiction. A summer smash."

An industry-only crowd will gather in Nashville on Thursday (October 2) to hear LBT perform the forthcoming project before the band hits the promotion trail prior to release. Although the *Pain Killer Tour 2014*, featuring the talented **Brett Eldredge** and **Brothers Osborne**, will only reach audiences as far as the Mountain Time Zone (Denver, Co.), the quartet will hit TV airwaves during the 48th Annual CMA Awards on November 5.

Voices Of Independent Promotions

Al Brock/Owner-CEO Spin Doctors Music Group, Nashville, TN

How did you get into the radio promotions business?

I moved back to Nashville after a successful 40 plus years in radio and wasn't 100% sure what I wanted to do. A few artist friends asked me to help get their songs played, and I started working records to radio.



What is your favorite thing about your work?

Working with indie artists and creative radio guys who love this music and are committed to excellence.

What is best about working with the *MusicRow* Panel? Indie and emerging artists get a decent shot and it's a very active reporting panel with programmers that make music decisions based on their gut and often take chances on a new artist's music.

Tell us about one of your proudest accomplishments?

We are proud to have been a part of Robby Johnson's success with "South Of Me" reaching the Top 20. Plus the high quality of artists we've worked with during the nearly 5 years we've been in business.

What is an interesting fact about yourself?

I am a walking encyclopedia of '60s and '70s Top 40 music and can tell anyone the year a song came out, what label it was on, and where it charted. And I'm also a grandfather to three amazing grandchildren.
