Top Ten— **Sam Hunt** is at the No. 1 spot this week with "Leave The Night On." **Chase Rice** moves one spot to No. 2 with "Ready Set Roll," followed by **Jason Aldean's** "Burnin' It Down" at No. 3. **Keith Urban's** "Somewhere In My Car" is also up one spot to No. 4 and **Blake Shelton's** "Neon Light" moves to No. 5. **Scotty McCreery** gains two spots on the chart with "Feelin' It" landing at No. 6. **Maddie & Tae** continue their climb with "Girl In A Country Song" moving up to No. 7. **Rascal Flatts** is at No. 8 with "Payback" and there are two new entries in the Top 10. **Brothers Osborne's** "Rum" is at No. 9 and **Frankie Ballard's** "Sunshine And Whiskey" comes in at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— **Carrie Underwood's** "Something In The Water" had the biggest gain this week with 765 new spins taking her to No. 27. **Kenny Chesney** had 405 additional plays for "Til It's Gone" and **Eric Church's** "Talladega" was up 281 spins. **Tim McGraw** moved up the chart after "Shotgun Rider" received 269 new spins, as did **Dierks Bentley's** "Say You Do."

Debuts— **The Band Perry** had the highest debut with "Gentle On My Mind" coming in at No. 69. Also new to the chart are **Kelsea Ballerini's** "Love Me Like You Mean It" at No. 78, **Gracia Harrison** at No. 79 with "Jezebel" and **James Robert Webb** at No. 80 with "Party In The Barn."

Wow! **Sam Hunt!** "Leave The Night On!" No. 1 on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart!

Perhaps to be expected from the same artist that brought "Come Over" (**Kenny Chesney**), "Cop Car" (**Keith Urban**) and "We Are Tonight" (**Billy Currington**). Hunt is a 29-year-old hit maker signed to MCA Nashville, already making waves with his debut.



Of course his A-list co-writers **Shane McAnally** and **Josh Osborne** don't hurt the cause of hitting No. 1 at radio. Not to mention, "Leave The Night On" is only a red-hot sample from the Georgia native's forthcoming album *Montevallo*, due to hit stores Oct. 27. The album has been teased with the *X2C* four-track sampler, released in August, all produced by **Zach Crowell** and McAnally.

The pop/R&B/hip hop-infused singer has gone Gold with this current radio single, currently selling over 600,000 tracks alongside over 30,000 units of that sampler.

He'll be out supporting the releases with the CMT Tour with **Kip Moore** and **Charlie Worsham** in addition to a tri-city album release on Oct. 30 in Greenville, Oct. 31 in Nashville and Nov. 1 in Birmingham. **Alan Young/Owner/Alan Young Promotions/
Los Angeles, CA**

How did you get into the radio promotions business?

I've loved music for as long as I can remember. My Dad worked for *Billboard* Publications and helped get me a job in the chart department which lead to a label promotion job, then independent promotion. Been doing this for 35 years now.

What is best about working with Radio stations on the *MusicRow* Panel?

Most stations that report to the *MusicRow* charts really care about playing the best songs possible for their listeners. There are a lot of independent artists that get exposure and become familiar thanks to these stations. Some acts even end up with major label deals because of this.



Tell us about one of your proudest accomplishments?

One proud moment was when "I Loved Her First" by Heartland came out and got such a phenomenal response, that it hit #1 on every chart, including three weeks on *MusicRow*. This song was on an indie label, owned by my friend, Mike Borchetta.

What is an interesting fact about yourself that others may not know?

I'm a wizard when it comes to music of the 50s, 60s & 70s. Also, most people don't know my real age.
