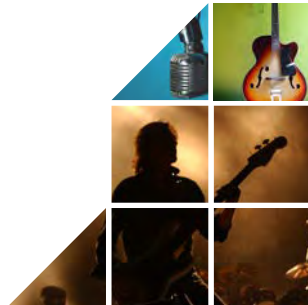

Oklahoma native Amy Jack is a proficient singer, songwriter, and producer. After graduating from the University of Oklahoma with a B.A. in TV/Radio/Film, she relocated to the Dallas- Fort Worth Metroplex in North Texas. As an account executive for IHeartMedia and Cumulus, she learned the ins and outs of the music and radio industries. To this day, Amy knows radio first hand.

Raised by family music teachers, Amy sings with ease and conviction. "Music is the most powerful mover in the world," she has said.

Amy has had several successes. Her song "For the Love of the Game" was recently featured on the U. S. Olympic Committee's 'Road to Rio' Tour as well as on national IHeartMedia stations, the ESPN Network during March Madness and on a featurette for Kobe Bryant on FOX Sports. Other recent career hi-lights include performing the National Anthem for Major League Baseball and having her song "Born To Lead," which she co-wrote with artist Billy Dawson, featured as the soundtrack to the NCAA's Rotary Lombardi Awards.

So what's next for Amy Jack? She is putting the finishing touches on forthcoming studio album which was co-written and produced by the late country music legend, Merle Haggard.
