Chris Young fans were able to get a first look at the list through a social media campaign. I'm Comin' Over features 11 new songs, nine of which Young co-wrote. The project also features several special guests, including Vince

Top Ten— Carrie Underwood takes the top spot this week with "Smoke Break." Cam moves to No. 2 with "Burning House" followed by Brothers Osborne at No. 3 with "Stay A Little Longer." Blake Shelton steps up two spots with "Gonna" at No 4. Tim McGraw is heading toward the top of the chart with "Top Of The World" moving up to No. 5. Dierks Bentley's "Riser" continues to be just that on the chart as it climbs to No. 6. Kelsea Ballerini is calling "Dibs" on the No. 7 position followed by Jason Aldean's "Gonna Know We Were Here" at No. 8. Cole Swindell moves up to No. 9 with "Let Me See Ya Girl." Erica Nicole has secured her first career Top 10 song with "I'm Making Mine" landing at No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers—Thomas Rhett elevated 10 positions to No. 28 with 372 new spins. Erica Nicole broke into the Top 10 with "I'm Making Mine" gaining 301. LoCash's "I Love This Life" continues the climb with 300 additional plays and Jana Kramer's "I Got The Boy" received 290 more. Mo Pitney is stepping closer to the Top 20 with 247 new plays putting him at No. 26 with "Boy And A Girl Thing."

Debuts— **Eric Paslay**'s "High Class" is the top debut at No. 62. **Dustin Lynch** is in this week with "Mind Reader" at No. 71. **William Michael Morgan's** debut song "I Met A Girl" moves on to the chart at No. 76. Also debuting this week are **Allie Louise**'s "Perfect Storm" at No. 77, **Leslie Cours Mather** at No. 78 with "Hell Hath No Fury," and **Sam Austin** at No. 79 with "Ain't It Good."



Carrie Underwood didn't waste any time or "take a break" while moving the first single from her forthcoming album up the chart. "Smoke Break" only took 9 weeks to reach the No. 1 spot on the MusicRow CountryBreakout

from her fifth studio album, *Storyteller*, which will be released through Arista Nashville on Oct. 23. The album was produced by Underwood's longtime producer **Mark Bright**, as well as **Jay Joyce** and **Zach Crowell**. Underwood co-wrote six of the project's 13 songs.

"Smoke Break" was written by Underwood along with song-writing stars **Chris DeStefano** and **Hillary Lindsey**. DeStefano is a frequent name on the track listings for Underwood. He also wrote chart-toppers such as "Something In The Water," "Little Toy Guns," (with Lindsey) and "Good Girl" for Underwood. Lindsey has now written seven chart-toppers for Underwood. More can be read about Lindsey here and and in the latest *MusicRow* publisher issue.

Carrie Underwood will appear on NBC's *Citi Concert Series on Today* on Oct. 23, the same day of the album release for *Storyteller*.

Underwood will then once again co-host the CMA Awards with **Brad Paisley** on Wed. Nov. 4 on ABC.
