Top Ten— "Ready Set Roll" by **Chase Rice** is the No. 1 song after 31 weeks on the chart. **Keith Urban** is up two spots to No. 2 with "Somewhere In My Car." **Blake Shelton's** "Neon Light" is also up two and lands at No. 3 this week. **Jason Aldean** drops one spot to No. 4 with "Burnin' It Down." **Scotty McCreery** makes a gain as "Feelin' It" is at No. 5 followed by **Maddie & Tae's** "Girl In A Country Song" at No. 6. **Rascal Flatts** is at No. 7 with "Payback" and **Frankie Ballard** is up two to No. 8 with "Sunshine & Whiskey." **Brad Paisley** breaks into the top 10 with "Perfect Storm" at No. 9 and **Brothers Osborne** slips one spot with "Rum" falling to No. 10.

Rob Hatch Receives No. 1 Challenge Coin

Songwriter **Rob Hatch** visited *MusicRow* to accept a No. 1 Challenge Coin for Lee Brice's "I Don't Dance," which he wrote with Brice and **Dallas Davidson**. Greatest Gainers— For the second week in a row, **Carrie Underwood** makes the greatest gain with 422 new spins. **Eric Church** moves "Talladega" up to No. 16 with 376 additional plays. **Lady Antebellum's** "Freestyle" breaks into the chart with spin gain of 329. **Brad Paisley** lands in the top 10 this week with "Perfect Storm" played 326 more times. **Dierks Bentley's** "Say You Do" is up 268 spins this week and moves to No. 42.

Debuts— **Lady Antebellum** had the highest debut this week with "Freestyle" at No. 61. **Eric Paslay's** "She Don't Love You" is new to the chart at No. 66. **Mike Ryan** makes his debut with "Dancing All Around It" at No. 78 and **Tim Sweeney's** "Every Friday Night" enters at No. 80.

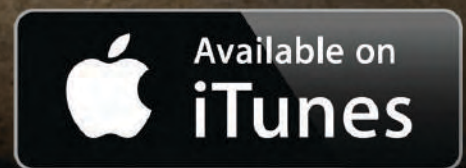

NO. 1 SONG

In a sense, **Chase Rice** has had both a long and short roll leading up to this week's No. 1. His "Ready Set Roll," written with **Rhett Akins** and **Chris DeStefano**, has taken a 31-week ride with both independent and major label contributions.



The now extinct RPM promotion staff was previously pushing the self-released Dack Janiels title, which reached the Top 40 before the Columbia Nashville team ignited the No. 1 launch.

Selling nearly 850k units to date, the song was previously the title track on the "Cruise" co-writer's self-released 2013 EP. Produced by the song's co-writers, "Ready Set Roll" became the major single from *Ignite The Night*, which was released by the major label in August.

Shortly before the venture, Rice told *MusicRow*, "When there's 2,000 people singing 'Ready Set Roll' every night, it's undeniable. I have no clue if Country radio will accept [my songs], but I know my fans will."

MusicRow's **Robert K. Oermann** noted of the single, "It's a guitar-stuttering country rocker that beckons a gal to embark on a night to remember. It's also addictive as all get out."

Currently the Country newcomer is on a [club tour](#), performing throughout the U.S. until the new year.

Voices Of Independent Promotion

Jerry Duncan/CEO/Jerry Duncan Promotions

How did you get into the radio promotion business?

I started out as a songwriter with Music Craftshop, and went to work for their parent company, Nationwide Sound Distributors. There I got a good overview of the entire record business from publishing, producing, marketing, etc. When they asked me to do promotion I loved working with radio, and have been doing it ever since.



What is your favorite thing about your work?

The most exciting thing is being a part of and seeing firsthand a career breakthrough. We've been fortunate to do that with some great breakthrough records like "Cruise" by **Florida Georgia Line**, "Austin" by **Blake Shelton**, "He Didn't Have To Be" by **Brad Paisley**, and "Indian Outlaw" by **Tim McGraw**.

What is best about working with stations on the *MusicRow* Panel?

The radio programmers are still passionate about the same thing we are: helping break great new records and artists.

Tell us about one of your proudest accomplishments.

Jerry Duncan Promotions just celebrated our 70th No. 1 single, "Dirt" by Florida Georgia Line. Being involved with them and their fantastic team from the beginning with "Cruise," and seeing them break so quickly from a brand new act on an small label to one of the biggest acts in the business has been very exciting.

What is a little known fact about you that might surprise others?

Pictured here is the tractor I drove as a teenager while working on our farm in Hanson, Kentucky. I put myself through college raising tobacco.
