## Arista Nashville Signs Logan Mize

Kansas native Logan Mize has joined the Sony Music's Arista Nashville imprint. Mize's first single with the major label will be "Can't Get Away from a Good Time," penned by Mize, Blake Chaffin, and Kelly Archer. Top Ten—Blake Shelton's "Neon Light" is the No. 1 Song week after climbing for 12 weeks. Maddie & Tae jump two spots to No. 2 with "Girl In A Country Song." Scotty McCreery is also up two with "Feelin' It" landing at No. 3. Brad Paisley's "Perfect Storm" is at No. 4 followed by Tim McGraw's "Shotgun Rider" at No. 5. Frankie Ballard is up to No. 6 with "Sunshine & Whiskey." Carrie Underwood's "Something In The Water," Garth Brooks' "People Loving People," Darius Rucker's "Homegrown Honey," and Eric Church's "Talladega" are all in the Top 10 for the First Time at No. 7, No. 8, No. 9, and No. 10 respectively.

**Greatest Gainers**— Florida Georgia Line was the big gainer this week with "Sun Daze" gaining 616 new spins. Kenny Chesney moved to No. 11 with "Til It's Gone" up 378 followed by Carrie Underwood's "Something In The Water." That was up 352 new plays and took her to the Top 10. The Band Perry's "Gentle On My Mind" was up 335 spins and Lady **Antebellum's** "Freestyle" gained 326 new plays.

**Debuts— Justin Moore** had the highest debut with "This Kind Of Town" coming in at No. 63. Billy Currington made it to No. 67 as a debut with "Don't It." Brian Collins is debuts "Never Really Left" on the chart at No. 73. Other songs on for this first time include Gunnar And The Grizzly Boys "Standard American" at No. 78, J. Michael Harter's "Holy Cowgirl" at No. 79 and Hicks' "Hayride" at No. 80.

If **Blake Shelton** has been praying for another No. 1, No. 1 No. 1, we've got his light at the end of the tunnel. For the past 12 weeks the Warner Nashville entertainer has been trying to un-break his heart at the bars, and this week performed "Neon Light" over 3,500 times to take the No. 1 spot on our CountryBreakout Chart.



**Andrew Dorff, Mark Irwin** and **Josh Kear** wrote the song, which was produced by Shelton's mainstay producer **Scott Hendricks**. The flagship artist released the title as the lead single from his quality, ninth studio album *Bringing Back The Sunshine*.

MusicRow's **Robert K. Oermann** reported of the single in late August, "Honky-tonk heartbreak brought right up to date with a sensational groove and brilliantly clever lyrics. Absolutely irresistible." It was not only the critics who enjoyed the song, but fans have cha-chinged the single 260K+ times on top of album sales already ringing in at over 150K.

Since Shelton is in Los Angeles on NBC's *The Voice*, his soonest tour date is not until 2015. But tune in to see him every Monday and Tuesday night on the network. Be sure to also listen out for his next radio single, because if they're off this album, there's bound to be another chart topper!

I like getting out in front on the major artists as quickly as possible. As far as indies go, I like to represent them well on our list but typically prefer a song


at least chart before we get on board. The one exception to that is if we have a local artist to report like **Bernie Nelson** or **Larry Fleet**, then we are on board right away.

We also like to think that being so close to Nashville (Dickson is 45 minutes out) that we must have a pretty special music playlist to win people away from the "Big Three" in Nashvegas.

Who are some of the New Artists that you are excited about? I really like what Kayla Adams and Kayla Calabrese are doing as they try to break in and I had a fantastic trio in studio recently called **The Cains Trio**. I think they all have the potential to be great in the future.
