Top Ten— Tim McGraw is at the top of the chart with "Top Of The World." He leaps over Blake Shelton, who remains at No. 2 with "Gonna." Jason Aldean moves one spot to No. 3 with "Gonna Know We Were Here." Dierks Bentley's "Riser" rises one to No. 4 followed by Kelsea Ballerini at No. 5 with "Dibs." Brad Paisley moves up to No. 6 with "Country Nation" and Billy Currington is up to No. 7 with "Drinking Town With A Football Problem." A Thousand Horses takes "(This Ain't No) Drunk Dial" up to No. 8 and Randy Houser steps up to No. 9 with "We Went." Jerrod Niemann cracks the top 10 with "Blue Bandana" at No. 10.

Greatest Spin Gainers— Keith Urban cruises to No. 28 after a spin increase of 470 for "Break On Me." Thomas Rhett is a step away from the Top 10 with 304 new spins for "Die A Happy Man." Brad Paisley moves "Country Nation" to No. 6 with 246 more plays and LoCash keeps the momentum for "I Love This Life" with 232 more. Justin Moore's new single, "You Look Like I Need A Drink," had a great first week with 226 spins.

Debuts—Brett Eldredge had the highest debut with "Drunk On Your Love" at No. 70. **Toby Keith**'s "Beautiful Stranger" is on the chart at No. 75 and **Dallas Smith** debuts at No. 78 with "Kids With Cars." **Mitchell Tenpenny** finally breaks the chart with "Love & Rock N Roll" at No. 80.

NO. 1 SONG

Tim McGraw takes "Top Of The World" straight to the top of the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart this week. It is the first single from his new album, Damn Country Music, available now. It is his 14th studio album and the third with Big Machine Records. Byron Gallimore took the



reins as producer, as he has done with all of McGraw's albums.

The single was written by Jon Nite, Josh Osborne, and Jimmy Robbins. Jon, Josh, and Jimmy are familiar names on top of the MusicRow chart. Nite will collect his fourth No. 1 Challenge Coin, Robbins will get his third and Osborne will collect Coin No. 9. "Top Of The World" is McGraw's fourth MusicRow No. 1 in two years.

McGraw was up early this week as he performed live on *Good* Morning America in front of Bridgestone Arena in Nashville on Wednesday morning as part of CMA Week.

He recently wrapped up his *Shotgun Rider* tour with openers Billy Currington and Chase Rice and is scheduled to headline at the Tortuga Music Festival in Ft Lauderdale in the spring.


