Top Ten— Tim McGraw's "Shotgun Rider" is at the No. 1 spot after only 12 weeks on the chart. Carrie Underwood continues her fast climb with "Something In The Water" landing at No. 2. Eric Church speeds to No. 3 with "Talladega" followed by Kenny Chesney's "Til It's Gone" at No. 4. Darius Rucker's "Homegrown Honey" is at No. 5 and Thomas Rhett moves two spots to No. 6 with "Make Me Wanna." Jake Owen remains at No. 7 another week with "What We Ain't Got." Lee Brice is up one to No. 8 with "Drinking Class." And making their Top 10 debuts are Chris Young at No. 9 with "Lonely Eyes" and Randy Houser's "Like A Cowboy" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— **Blake Shelton** was the biggest gainer this week with "Lonely Eyes" up 488 new plays. **Luke Bryan** is up 11 spots after "I See You" saw 424 new spins. **Garth Brooks** had a big first week with "Mom" getting 358 new spins in its debut week. **Jason Aldean's** "Just Gettin' Started" gained 349 new plays **Florida Georgia Line** continue their climb with "Sun Daze" up 286 spins.

Debuts— Garth Brooks had the highest debut with "Mom" landing at No. 59. Also new the chart are **The Cains Trio** at No. 77 with "Be Yourself With Me," **Gloriana**'s "Trouble" at No. 79 and **North 40** at No. 80 with "Whole Lot Of Livin."



NO. 1 SONG

Tim McGraw is most certainly speaking of wife Faith Hill when he sings on the No. 1 song on the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart this week, "Shotgun Rider. "

The hit was written by Hillary Lindsey, Marv Green and Troy Verges, and is a country boy's love song about not wanting anyone else riding shotgun right beside him except his true love.



Tim fans may recognize the title of this song from his 2007 album, Let It Go. True, the title is the same but it is a completely different song. The 2007 album cut was a duet with wife Faith. Robert Oermann called this week's chart-topping song "...a perfect roll-the-top-down and take-to-the-highway song. A single with its own built-in breeze" in his DISClaimer review. Produced by McGraw and his longtime producer Byron Gallimore, "Shotgun Rider" is the third single from his second studio album for Big Machine Records, Sundown Heaven Town, and his second No. 1 song from the album on the MusicRow CountryBreakout Chart after "Meanwhile, Back At Mama's" which made it to the top on July 17, 2014.

While McGraw is done touring for 2014, he still has a performance for A Very Grammy Christmas headed to CBS next month. According to McGraw's Official Website, the singer won't have to hit the road again until he performs at the Stagecoach Festival in Indio, CA on April 24, 2015.




Voices Of Secondary Radio
