Top Ten— Carrie Underwood takes the Top Spot this week with "Something In The Water." Kenny Chesney moves up two spots to No. 2 with "Til It's Gone." Eric Church's "Talladega" remains at No. 3 for another week and last week's No. 1, Tim McGraw's "Shotgun Rider," falls to No. 4. Darius Rucker is at No. 5 another week with "Homegrown Honey," and Thomas Rhett also remains in the same spot for a second week with "Make Me Wanna" at No. 6. Lee Brice is up one spot to No. 7 with "Drinking Class." Jake Owen falls one spot with "What We Ain't Got" landing at No. 8. Chris Young's "Lonely Eyes" is again at No. 9 followed by Randy Houser's "Like A Cowboy" remaining at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— Garth Brooks had a big gain this week with "Mom" moving up 15 spots after 445 new plays this week. Luke Bryan's "I See You" was another big mover with 344 new spins. Kenny Chesney climbs to No. 2 on the chart this week after 185 additional spins of "Til It's Gone." Jason Aldean also had 185 new spins for his new song "Just Gettin' Started." And Blake Shelton's "Lonely Tonight" was last weeks biggest gainer and this week saw 182 new spins.

Debuts— **Rachel Holder** was the highest debut with "I Think Of You" debuting at No. 66. Also new to the chart is **Joy Styles**' "Fast" at No. 77, **Elizabeth Lyons** and "Party Rules" landing at No. 79 and **John Spicer'**s "Pretty Good at Loving You" at No.

Nine must be Carrie Underwood's lucky number. The mother-tobe only needed nine weeks for "Something In The Water" to ring the bell at this week's No. 1 spot on the CountryBreakout Chart. Underwood wrote the title with Chris DeStefano and Brett **Iames,** who were both knighted for songwriting success during a trip near

Bordeaux, France.



The hit single will be included in the superstar's *Greatest Hits:* Decade #1 album, due to hit shelves on Dec. 9. As part of a twodisc collection, the 25-track project will feature two new songs, along with four new versions or previously released material (live and worktape versions).

People magazine exclusively premiered the official music video for the single earlier this month, featuring professional dancers and a pregnant Underwood.

Underwood, who co-hosted this year's CMA Awards and received favorite female vocalist at the AMA awards, will be featured on the upcoming December TV specials: CMA Country Christmas (Dec. 1) and the American Country Countdown Awards (Dec. 13).




