Top Ten— **Eric Church** speeds to the No. 1 spot this week with "Talladega." **Darius Rucker** is up one spot to No. 2 with "Homegrown Honey" followed by **Thomas Rhett's** "Make Me Wanna" at No. 3. **Lee Brice** moves up to No. 4 with "Drinking Class." **Jake Owen** is at No. 5 with "What We Ain't Got." **Florida Georgia Line's** "Sun Daze" is up to No. 6 and **Chris Young's** "Lonely Eyes" lands at No. 7. **Randy Houser** gains one spot to No. 8 with "Like A Cowboy." **Luke Bryan** makes a big jump into the Top 10 with "I See You" up seven spots to No. 9. **Tyler Farr** is at No. 10 again this week with "A Guy Walks Into A Bar."

Greatest Gainers— **Luke Bryan** breaks into the Top 10 and lands at No. 9 after 413 new spins this week. **Blake Shelton** is on his way up with "Lonely Tonight." The song saw 398 additional plays this week. **Jason Aldean's** "Just Gettin' Started" was up 272 spins and **Garth Brooks' "Mom"** up 255. **Sam Hunt's** "Take Your Time" moved up 15 spots thanks to 240 new plays.

NO. 1 SONG

One last *MusicRow* chart for the year comes next week. Looking back, one might say 2014 has been the year country radio took time to reflect on life. Looking at hits "Automatic" (Lambert), "I Hold On" (Bentley), or "Dirt" (FGL), all titles bring about a nostalgic sense to allow the listener time to reflect on legacies built one day at a time. This week's CountryBreakout Chart hit falls in that same ballpark, joining "Bring Me Back My Hometown," from **Eric Church's** album *The Outsiders* album, the fourth single called "Talladega."

Written by Church and **Luke Laird**, the title longs for the youthful innocence that fades over time. Although the song's lyrics are based on the Talladega Superspeedway, Laird and Church are no doubt writing about the existential relationships and experiences that endure throughout life.

Have any doubts? Take a peek at the **Peter Zavadil**-directed [music video](#), which premiered one week ago (Dec. 4). The video didn't even need to be filmed at the legendary speedway in Lincoln, Ala. The Nashville Speedway offered the setting while the final concept was augmented with archival Super 8mm footage of family, celebration and racetracks.

Church is on the road with **Dwight Yoakam** and **Halestorm** on his own *The Outsiders World Tour* through Dec. 13 before heading out for an extended leg in January 2015. We're looking forward to more radio hits, too. For tickets to Church's live shows, visit ericchurch.com.

Skip Clark /Program Director/WOLF105.1 & 96.7/Syracuse NY

How long have you been at your station?

I have been in the building since Feb. 16, 2006. New Country WOLF 105.1 & 96.7 was put on the air Aug. 28, 2009.

How many "hats" do you wear?

I wear many hats. That pretty much seems to be the norm nowadays for all of us working in the industry.

What is your philosophy on new music?

New music needs to be heard. If it fits what our listeners are looking for, then chances are I am going to give it a shot.

Why is it important for you to report to *MusicRow*?
